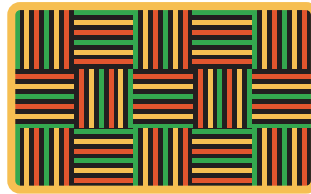

Symbols of Kwanzaa

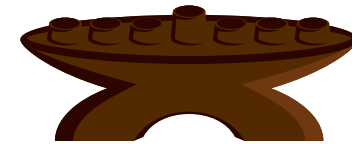
Mazao (The Crops) represents the harvest crops or rewards of lab



Mkeka (The Mat) represents the foundation of tradition



Kinara (The Candle Holder) represents ancestors



Mishumaa Saba (The Seven Candles)
Three red, three green, and one black candle: each color is symbolic



Zawado (The Gifts) represents the commitment of the parents to the children and from the children to the parents

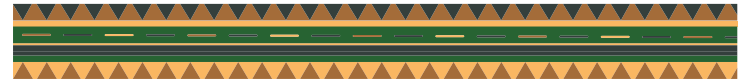


Kikaombe cha Umoja

Muhindi (The Corn) represents children or hope for the future





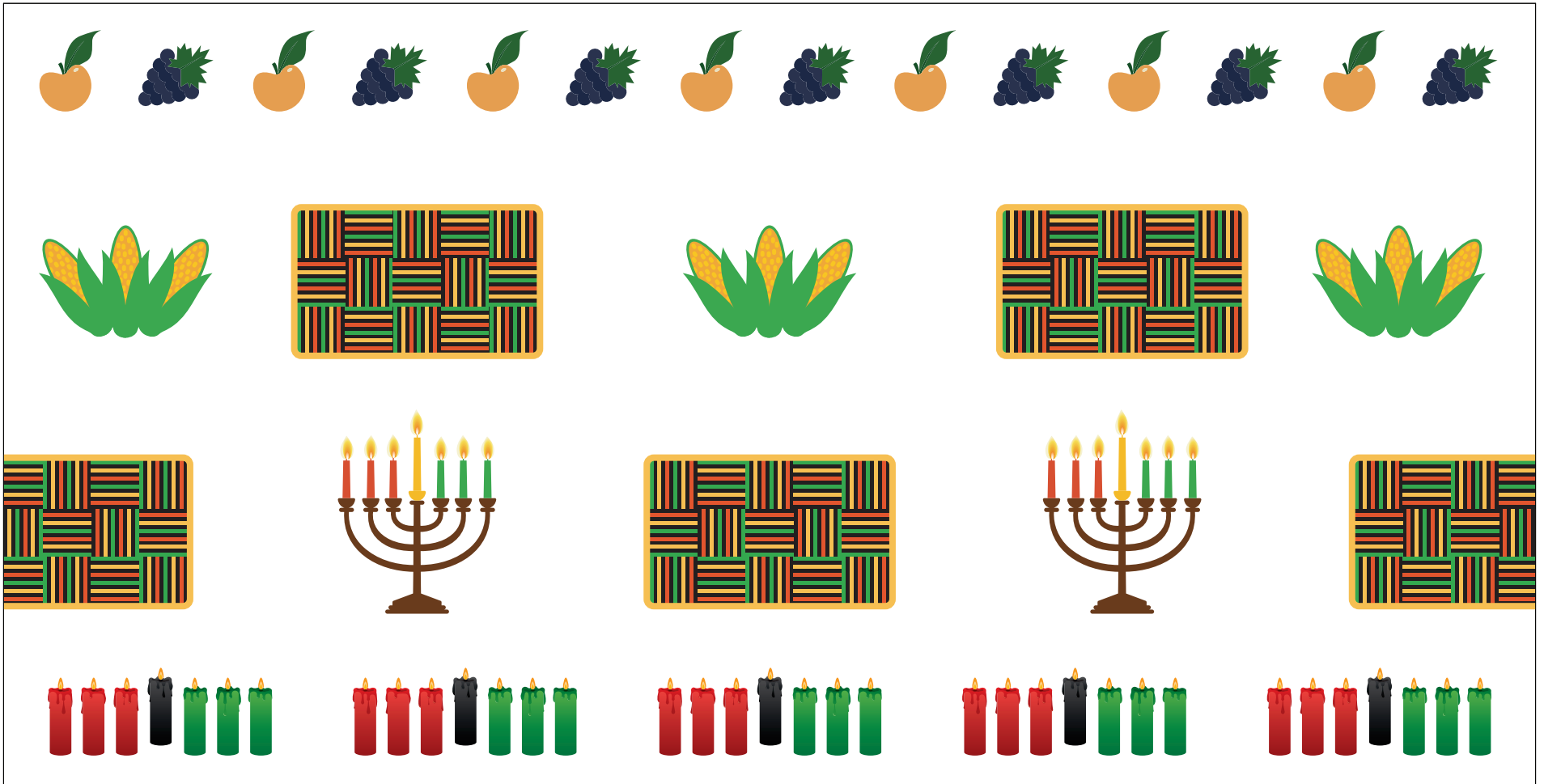
