<i>Problem #1.</i>	12 r 3 bunches of balloons.	<i>Ignore it</i>
<i>Problem #2.</i>	25 r 3 boxes.	<i>Round up</i>
<i>Problem #3.</i>	23 r 4 = $23\frac{1}{2}$ granola bars.	<i>Report as a fraction</i>
<i>Problem #4.</i>	12 r 0 crates.	<i>No remainder</i>
<i>Problem #5.</i>	24 r 2 = $24\frac{2}{9}$ candy bars.	<i>Report as a fraction</i>
