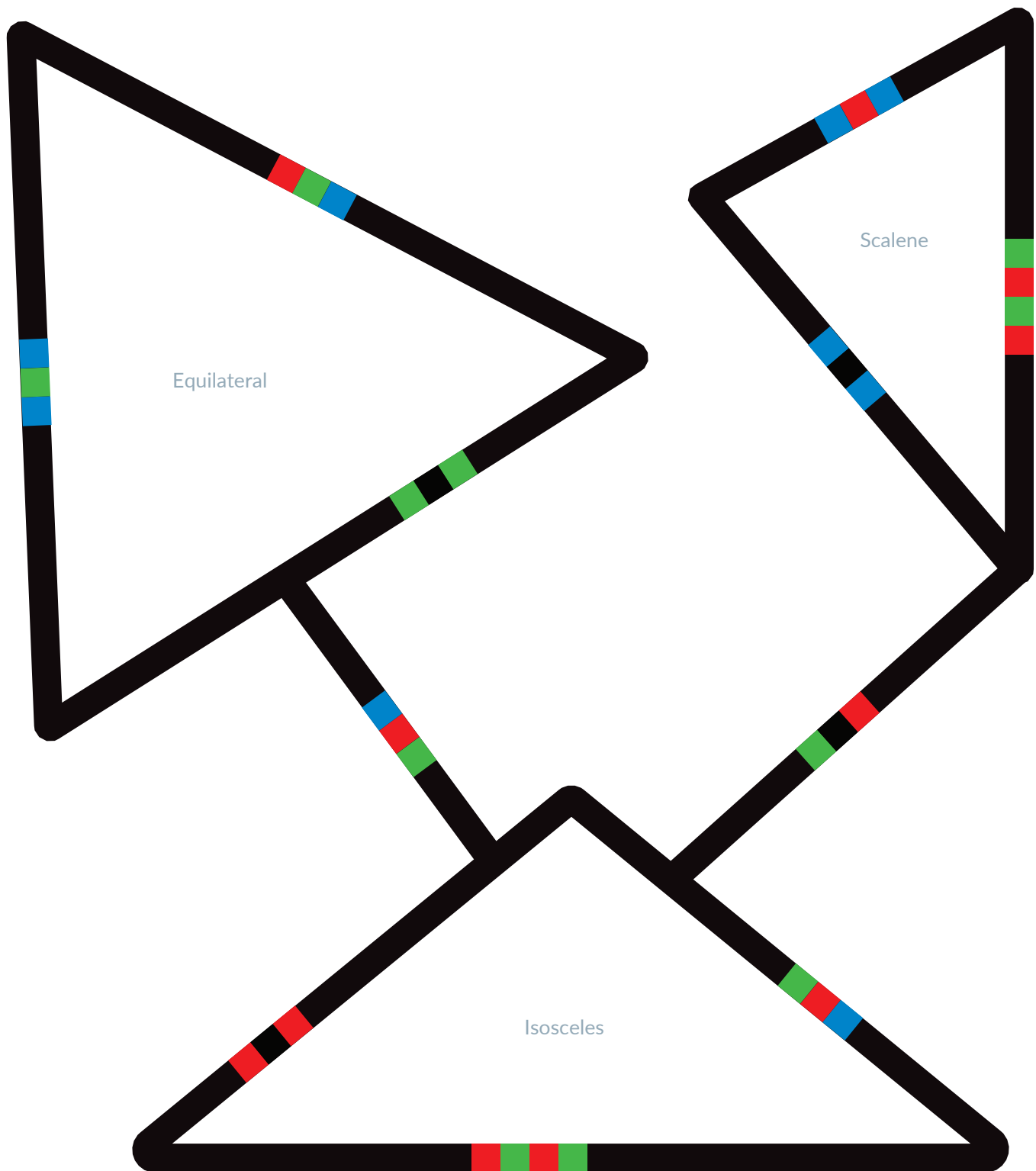




My triangle's name is: _____ Henrietta _____
